He reviewed the estimated annual fund fees for 2018; fees were based on a 7.5% increase in assets and an agency contribution of \$6.5 times average fund fees of 53bps, which equaled \$877,681.00 in budgeted fees. Joseph Petty did note that the estimate actuarial fee should be increased to \$5,000.00 to account for GASB requirements. The total budget is \$1,411,430.00 for 2018. It was also noted that custodial fees should be \$40,000.00 less then paid in 2016.
